

## TUNIS.

TUNIS, JUNE 30.

Telegraphic communication with Sfax continues to be interrupted. The official news just received from Susa by telegraph states that yesterday it was deemed necessary to land troops at Brat from a French steamer, that the Arabs became greatly excited, and fired on the steamer to prevent the landing. It is also stated that the French Vice-Consul has been wounded, and that the Europeans greatly alarmed, are taking refuge on board the ships in the harbour.

LATER.

A telegram received from Mehdiä reports that the Arabs are in a state of great excitement in that town, and that the revolted tribes are threatening to attack Sfax.
