INDIA.

CALCUTTA, JULY 25.

The tenders received for the new Four per Cent. Loan amount to 108,430,300 rupees. Tenders at 104½ and upward will receive 53 per cent.

FRANCE AND TUNIS.

MALTA, JULY 25.

Her Majesty's ironclad Monarch has arrived here from Sfax, and reports that all is quiet there. It was anticipated that the French would enter Mehdiä to-morrow.

NO TH AFRICA.

SAÏDA, JULY 24.

A French column, composed of about 2,500 men, will set out from this place on the 4th of August to occupy certain important strategical positions, to chastise the disaffected tribes, and to protect those who have remained faithful to the French. Two thousand camels have been requisitioned for the expedition, whose objective will probably be Tiout or Asla.

EGYPT.

CAIRO, JULY 25.

The cattle plague in the province of Siout is now decreasing.

The height of the Nile to-day is 9 cubits 17 kirats. On the same date last year it was 12 cubits 23 kirats.

The members of the Abyssinian Mission, who will soon be leaving Cairo, are engaging a great number of workmen to go with them to Abyssinia. They decline to engage any Roman Catholics.

The Minister of Finance has decided to have the new silver piastres coined in Paris.
