Monastir, June 29, 4:00, evening.

I arrive from Sfax, which was invaded by the Arabs of the exterior, risen against the authority of the bey. The members of the various European colonies are on board the battleships offshore and on the French gunboat. The day before yesterday, the battleship *Alma* left la Goulette for Sfax, transporting approximately 1,500 troops of the bey.

The steamer *Moustapha-es-Sadok*, of the transatlantic company, carried at the same time 150 Tunisian artillerymen. These troops were to arrive at Sfax yesterday evening or tonight. The telegraph to Sfax does not function since yesterday afternoon. It is supposed that it is the dissidents that cut the wire.
