

VILLEFRANCHE, June 26.—Two battalions of troops and 200 gendarmes lining the route prevented a popular demonstration as 620 men of the mutinous Seventeenth Infantry marched to-day from the train to the wharf, where they embarked on the cruisers *Desaix* and *Du Chayla* for Sfax, Tunis.

As soon as the men were on board the cruisers headed out to sea.
