

KERKENNA ISLANDS RAID MADE FROM MALTA

It is now revealed that the recent occupation of the Kerkenna Islands, off Sfax, was the work of a raiding unit from the Malta garrison. The raiding unit left Malta in great secrecy and stopped at Tripoli and Sfax *en route*. On the night of April 13 the unit reached and occupied the two islands of Rharbi and Chargui without opposition, and was disappointed to find that the Italian garrison had been gone for two days. The expedition was perfectly timed with the cooperation of the Navy. The greatest danger met was the spiked fish traps around Kerkenna. The expedition is now safe back in Malta.
